Chairman's Comments

Matt. 8:5-13, Note v8 & v.10 The centurion replied, "Lord, I do not deserve to have you come under my roof. But just say the word, and my servant will be healed. When Jesus heard this, he was amazed and said to those following him, "Truly I tell you, I have not found anyone in Israel with such great faith. " When the Centurion meets Jesus he shows remarkable courage and faith. He obviously had an assurance that Jesus was the answer to his servants need and his as well. Can I say that I wish I had that much faith. Maybe the positive nature he saw in Jesus spurred him on into this level of faith. Personally I might profess faith in Jesus' power but is that the core belief deep within my heart? "Examine my heart oh Lord." Our words have the power of life and death. After the Creation God looked at what He had made and declared, "It is Good!". He affirmed life into what He had made. This is an affirmative proclamation. Our words, whether positive or negative, have a direct influence

over the atmosphere of where we are and to whom we are speaking. Gossip, (second-hand tales that may not be true!), complaining, speaking negatives, will effect others within your earshot. The atmosphere becomes shrouded with doubt and gloom. Positive words and affirmations shared in conversations will lift the atmosphere and encourage others, building hope and strength promoting assurance. This drives the hearer onto growth and advancement. The Centurion had received a positive Hope that He had gained by watching and hearing Jesus. As with Jesus' words our words have power. Power to give life, or power to kill, build or destroy. Use them wisely! The choice of affirmation or degradation will determine what we declare over our life and those around us. If we say so - it shall be done. See also Eph.4:29, Prov.16:24.
